The proposal is to abstract water at the following rates and periods for use in hydroelectric power production and domestic supply: 53.7 cubic metres an hour, 1,280.48 cubic metres a day and 293,314 cubic metres a year, all year.</p> <p>Application is also being made for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of Un-named Tributary of the Afon y Foel at National Grid Reference SH 76167 45675 at the above location.
